



EVANGELIZE WEEK

Month 2: KNOWN

“God, I am fully known by You.”

“Father, help us reach **EVERY LAST ONE** on our campus with Your **HOPE!**”

WELCOME

LEADER TIP: Arriving early to pray over the room, playing worship live or on a bluetooth speaker, and greeting attendees as they enter, creates an environment that welcomes God’s presence and people well.

Welcome: _____ (Leader)

SAY: Welcome to First Priority! We are so happy you joined us today! This month, we have been talking about how we are fully **KNOWN** by God! This week is **EVANGELIZE** week, where we will talk about how God can use us to help reach **EVERY LAST ONE** at our school! Our **EVANGELIZE** GOAL is for every one of us to confidently say, “I **know** that **EVERY LAST ONE**, including me, is fully **known** by God.”

Prayer: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: Feel free to add your own words to this prayer.

SAY: Let’s pray. “Father, we **know** that we are fully **known** and loved by You and that You want **EVERY LAST ONE** on our campus to **know** You. Show us today who in this room and in our school needs to **know** You personally. In Jesus’ Name, amen.” (2 Peter 3:9)

WORSHIP (OPTIONAL)

Worship Transition Talk: _____ (Leader)

SAY: God sent His Son, Jesus, so that **EVERY LAST ONE** could **know** Him! Let’s take time to worship God, thanking Him for sending Jesus so that we can **know** Him!

Message Transition Prayer: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: Psalm 100:3a says, “**Know** that the Lord, He is God!” When we worship, our hearts open to **know** God more! Feel free to add your own words to this prayer.

SAY: “God, we praise You and thank You for **knowing** us. May we **know** what Your Word says today as we prepare to reach **EVERY LAST ONE** in our school with the hope of Your Son, Jesus.”

SAY: This month’s verse is Psalm 139:14 which says, “I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful, I **know** that full well.”

MESSAGE

Message: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: If you’d like to write the message in your own words, use the MESSAGE TIPS portion of the CLUB PLAN TEMPLATE provided at the end of this week’s lesson.

LEADER TIP: Before this week’s club meeting, access the First Priority **RESPONSE CARDS** and print enough for your entire club. Make sure your LEADERSHIP TEAM has a clear plan for everyone to receive a **RESPONSE CARD**. When club ends, student leaders should collect **RESPONSE CARDS** to prepare for follow up with students who completed them. **IMPORTANT: RESPONSE CARDS** can be found on the FP AL app within **EVANGELIZE WEEK** and in **CLUB RESOURCES**.

SAY: This month, our scripture comes from Psalm 139, a chapter of the Bible that was written by David. We **know** from what we have learned that David was “a man after God’s own heart.” (1 Samuel 13:14; Acts 13:22) This means that David was devoted to God and wanted to please Him. During the time He spent with the Lord, David wrote many psalms (“songs”) that show his love for God. Just like David, we can spend time with God and get to **know** Him more. But our journey doesn’t stop here. Once we get to **know** God more, we can share what we **know** about His love with everyone we **know!**

This week is E week, also known as **Evangelize** week. The word “**evangelize**” means “to share the Gospel.” The “Gospel” is the good news of Jesus! This good news is that God loved us so much that He gave His Son, Jesus, to save us from our sin! God’s Word tells us in Romans 10:17 that it is “beautiful” when we share the “good news!” 1 John 3:1 tells us, “See how very much our Father loves us, for He calls us His children, and that is what we are! But the people who belong to this world don’t recognize that we are God’s children because they don’t **know** Him.” When we surrender our lives to God and get to **know** Him as our Father, He calls us His children! That’s good news! But this verse doesn’t stop at this idea. It shows us the responsibility that we as God’s children have to share the hope of Jesus with **EVERY LAST ONE!** Those who belong to the world don’t recognize that we’re God’s children because they don’t **know** Him! How will they **know** Him? They will **know** Him when we share the good news of Jesus with them!

Our focus for this year in First Priority is our identity, which we **know** is the characteristics that make us who we are. We can’t fully **know** who we are without **knowing** God and having a personal relationship with Him. If we have never surrendered our lives to God and asked His Son, Jesus, to be our Lord, we do not **know** Him. You may be here today wondering, “How can I **know** God?” You can **know** God by reading what His Word says. Romans 3:23 tells us, “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” Sin separates us from God and we have all sinned. But thankfully, God made a way for us to be forgiven of our sins so that we don’t have to be separated from Him any longer! God sent His Son, Jesus, to make all things new! 2 Corinthians 5:17 says, “anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!”



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MESSAGE (continued)

If you want to **know** God today, you can invite Him into your life right now before we leave this room. Romans 10:9 says, *“If you declare with your mouth, ‘Jesus is Lord,’ and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”* If we want to surrender our lives to Jesus, this verse tells us that we must confess our sins to God, declare that Jesus is Lord, and believe that Jesus is the only Way to God. If you want to **know** God and surrender your life to Him, I will take my time as I say this prayer so you can repeat after me: **LEADER TIP:** Say this slowly in clear, short phrases: *“God, I confess to You that I am a sinner and I ask for Your forgiveness. I believe that You sent Your Son Jesus to die for my sins. I believe that He rose again and is the only Way to You. (John 14:6) Today, I surrender my life to You. I want to know You as my Heavenly Father. In Jesus’ Name, amen.”*

If you prayed to surrender your life to Jesus today, we want to celebrate with you! This is an amazing decision! If you have questions or you aren’t sure yet about giving your life to Jesus, our student leaders or our Campus Coach would love to talk with you. Please make sure you fill out a **RESPONSE CARD** before you leave and give it to one of our student leaders. We are here for you and want to support you as our brothers and sisters in Christ! Welcome to God’s family!

LET’S TALK ABOUT IT (OPTIONAL)

LEADER TIP: If you have time available, discuss these questions in a small group or large group setting. For small groups, select a leader for each group.

GROUP LEADER(S) SAY:

1. How can you **know** God?
2. How will our campus **know** that we **know** God?
3. Reaching **EVERY LAST ONE** begins with reaching the **NEXT ONE**.
Who do I **know** that needs to **know** God?

LEADER TIP: Explain that reaching **EVERY LAST ONE** simply begins with the **NEXT ONE**.

CLOSING

Identity Statement: _____ (Leader)

SAY: Proverbs 18:21 tells us that we have power to speak life! As we leave today, let’s speak life over our identity together! Say this in your heart or out loud after me: “I believe that **EVERY LAST ONE** is fully **known** and loved by God.”

Promo/Announcements: _____ (Leader)

SAY: “We can’t wait to see you next week! Pray about who the Lord wants you to invite! Don’t forget to follow our club on social media!”

LEADER TIP: Your social media team members may want to create a graphic to post with this month’s verse or the Identity Statement. Encourage your classmates to follow the club’s social media account, if you have one, and share graphics for upcoming club meetings and events.

Sample wording for the graphic: “I am fully **known** and loved by God! - Psalm 139:14”

IMPORTANT: If your club doesn’t have a social media account, check with your Faculty Sponsor for approval.

Closing Prayer: _____ (Leader)

LEADERS’ RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Dismiss attendees to class based upon Faculty Sponsor’s direction.
2. Clean your club meeting space, removing any trash.
3. Reset all items in your club meeting space to their original positions.
