SAY: Welcome to First Priority! Thank you so much for joining us today! First Priority is a student-led, Gospel-focused club that aims to take the hope of Jesus to every student on our campus! SAY: Today's verse is Genesis 1:26a-27 which says, "Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image.' So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them."

SAY: During each opportunity week, we will take the opportunity to identify and overcome any obstacles that get in the way of us knowing Who God is and who He says we are! Let's talk about one of the biggest obstacles that can get in the way of us confidently believing that God is our **Creator** and that we are **created** in His image. Has it ever been hard for you to believe that God was real because you couldn't see or feel Him? Has it ever been difficult to believe that the **Creator** of the world made you in His image? If you've ever experienced this, you have probably felt what is called "doubt." The word "doubt" means "to be uncertain about something or someone, or to have difficulty believing something." Doubt is one of the greatest obstacles that the devil can use to distract us from believing the truth. But God has given us the ability to overcome these doubts by something called "faith!"

The definition of "faith" is "complete trust or confidence in someone or something." The Bible defines faith in Hebrews 11:1 which says, "Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see." Romans 10:17 tells us how we can receive faith. It says, "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." In these verses, the Bible is telling us that we can have faith by hearing God's Word! Having faith in God's Word gives us confidence that God is our **Creator** and we are **created** in His image. Proverbs 30:5 tells us "every word of God proves true." By reading and listening to God's Word, we can grow in our faith and believe that what His Word says is true. Since we read Romans 10:17, let's allow our faith to rise together as we listen to how much truth the Bible holds about Who God is as our Creator.

Hebrews 11:3 says, "By faith we understand that the entire universe was formed at God's command, that what we now see did not come from anything that can be seen."

John 1:3 says, "Everything came into existence through Him. Not one thing that exists was made without Him."

Colossians 1:16 says, "He created all things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible. Whether they are kings or lords, rulers or powers- everything has been created through Him and for Him."

Psalm 33:6 says, "The Lord merely spoke, and the heavens were **created**. He breathed the word, and all the stars were born."

Jeremiah 10:12 says, "The Lord made the earth by His power; by His wisdom He **created** the world and stretched out the heavens."

Hebrews 3:4 says, "For every house has a builder, but the One who built everything is God."

Psalm 89:11 says, "The heavens are Yours, and the earth is Yours; everything in the world is Yours—You **created** it all."

Acts 17:24a says, "The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth."

One of the amazing things about our **Creator** God is that He isn't afraid of our doubt and our questions. He loves us so much that He wants us to experience His presence in our lives in real ways that overcome the doubt the enemy wants us to feel. It's so important for us to have friends who also follow Jesus so that when we have moments of doubt, we can ask them to pray with us and encourage us. Followers of Jesus need to have a church family where they can find community and encouragement. If you ever start to feel doubt, you can talk to our First Priority Campus Coach, a parent, a pastor, a youth pastor, a youth leader, a children's pastor, or a Godly mentor. Let's look for **opportunities** today to overcome doubt with God's truth!
