Month 3: MASTERPIECE "God, I am Your masterpiece!"

LEADER TIP: Arriving early to pray over the room, playing worship live or on a bluetooth speaker, and greeting attendees as they enter, creates an environment that welcomes God's presence and people well.

SAY: Today's verse is Ephesians 2:10 which says, "For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago."

SAY: During OPPORTUNITY week, we learn to take the opportunities to overcome any obstacles that come against us knowing Who God is and who He says we are. Today, we are going to look at how we can overcome some of the obstacles in the way of us believing that we are God's masterpiece. An "obstacle" is anything that blocks something or gets in the way. The enemy wants to block us from believing the truth that comes from God. (Genesis 3:1-13; Matthew 4:1-11) God wants us to believe the truth about Him and about who He says we are!

Jesus tells us that the enemy wants to destroy us. In John 10:10, Jesus says, "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." In this verse, the word "thief" is talking about our enemy, the devil. One way that he tries to destroy us is through our thoughts. The enemy wants our minds to be filled with his lies about Who God is and who God says we are. However, we have the opportunity to overcome the obstacles of the enemy's lies! The truth that overcomes every obstacle comes from the Bible, which is God's Word. (Proverbs 30:5)

Last week during HEART week, we learned the truth that God is love. (1 John 4:8) The enemy wants us to believe the lie that God doesn't love us. The truth that overcomes this lie is found in First John 4:16. It says, "And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them." Today, we can know for sure that we are **loved!**

Another lie that the enemy wants us to believe is that we aren't good enough. One of the greatest weapons the enemy tries to use against us is insecurity. "Insecurity" is a lack of self-confidence or a doubt about oneself. When we struggle with insecurity, we might battle these questions: "Am I good enough? Does anyone care about me? Does anyone love me? Does anyone notice me? Can I really share the Gospel with others? What if they think I'm weird?" When we feel insecure, we might have these thoughts: "I'm not smart enough. I'm not pretty enough. I'm not athletic enough. I'm not strong enough. I'm not outgoing enough. No one wants to be friends with me. I always feel like I'm a bother to everyone. No one wants me."



Month 3: MASTERPIECE

The truth of God's Word overcomes the obstacle of insecurity! Ephesians 2:10 tells us, "For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago." A masterpiece is a work of outstanding art, skill, or workmanship. While creating a masterpiece, an artist is extremely careful to make their work of art as amazing as possible. The artist isn't going to rush the process of creating their masterpiece. They are going to take their time to make something so special that they are extremely proud of. Did you know that God took time to create each one of us? (Psalm 139:13-17) He made us all carefully in His image, as His masterpiece! (Genesis 1:26a-27) Psalm 139:14 says, "I praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Marvelous are Your works, and I know this very well." This truth from God's Word shows us just how special and important we are! Because of Who God is and who He says we are, we can confidently know that we are loved, wanted, valued, and seen. When we feel like no one loves us, we can be reminded that our Creator God created us in His image as His masterpiece.

Do you know someone who needs to hear that they are God's masterpiece? Is there someone in your class or someone who sits at your lunch table who needs encouragement? Proverbs 18:21 tells us, "The tongue can bring death or life." This means that our words have the power to build someone up or tear them down. (James 3:1-12) We don't want our words to be the obstacle in the way of someone believing that they are God's masterpiece. We want our words to encourage others and show them how much God loves them. Today, let's look for an opportunity to use our words to encourage others, and tell them that they are God's masterpiece.
