



EVANGELIZE WEEK

Month 1: GOSPEL

“Father, help us reach **EVERY LAST ONE** on our campus with Your HOPE!”

WELCOME

LEADER TIP: Arriving early to pray over the room, playing worship live or on a bluetooth speaker, and greeting attendees as they enter, creates an environment that welcomes God’s presence and people well.

Welcome: _____ (Leader)

SAY: Welcome to First Priority! We are so glad you are here today! This month we have been learning that our purpose is to know God! This week is EVANGELIZE week, where we will talk about how God can use us to reach EVERY LAST ONE at our school. The word “evangelize” means “to share the gospel.” The “gospel” is the Good News of Jesus! This Good News is that God loved us so much that He gave His Son, Jesus, to save us so that we could know Him! Before we leave today, we will all have the opportunity to begin a relationship with Jesus and learn how we can share the gospel with others!

Prayer: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: Feel free to have a student leader pray in their own words or the use prayer below.

SAY: Let’s pray. “God, thank You for loving us so much that You sent Your Son, Jesus, to save us. We know that Your heart is for EVERY LAST ONE on our campus to know You. Show us who in this room and in our school needs to know You, so that we can tell them about You. In Jesus’ Name, amen.”

WORSHIP (OPTIONAL)

Worship Transition Talk: _____ (Leader)

SAY: God sent His Son, Jesus, so that EVERY LAST ONE could know Him! When we truly know God and understand all that He has done for us, it’s so easy to give Him our worship! Let’s worship Him together, thanking Him for sending Jesus!

LEADER TIP: Worship can be led live or by a lyric video. Test all technology WELL BEFORE club begins. Because students come from diverse worship backgrounds, provide lyrics (in slides, handouts, or a QR code) so everyone can participate. Message Transition Prayer: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: Worship is a powerful time to invite God’s presence. To carefully transition into the message, have a student leader pray in their own words or use the prayer below.

SAY: “God, we worship You because You deserve our worship! We are thankful that we have the opportunity to know You and have a relationship with You. As we talk about the Good News of Jesus, help us to be bold and share Your hope with EVERY LAST ONE in our school. If someone in this room doesn’t know You, help them choose to begin a personal relationship with You today. In Jesus’ Name, amen.”

MESSAGE

Scripture: _____ (Leader)

SAY: Today’s verse is from 2 Peter 3:9, which says, “The Lord is not slow in keeping His promise, as some understand slowness. Instead He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.”

Message: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: Before a club meeting, print enough First Priority RESPONSE CARDS for everyone to receive one. RESPONSE CARDS can be found on the FP AL app within EVANGELIZE WEEK and in CLUB RESOURCES. Following the message, student leaders should collect RESPONSE CARDS to follow up with those who completed them.

SAY: This month we have been talking about how our purpose is to know God. I want all of us to ask ourselves this question: Do I really know God? Do I have a personal relationship with Jesus? If your answer is “yes,” that’s great! If you’re not sure, you can be sure before you leave today! Second Peter 3:9 tells us that God’s heart is for everyone to know Him. He wants everyone or EVERY LAST ONE to repent. When we “repent,” we ask Jesus to forgive us of our sin and to help us be more like Him. The word “repent” means to turn away from sin, allowing our mind to be transformed to think more like Jesus. To have a relationship with Jesus, we must turn away from our sin, turn to Him, and ask Him to help us be more like Him. Isaiah 59:2 tells us that “sin” separates us from God. The word “sin” means missing the mark, or falling short of God’s ways. Romans 3:23 says, “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” We have all sinned. We all must repent and turn to Jesus. He is the only One Who can save us. He is the only One Who can help us live like Him.

A “testimony” is our story of how we turned to Jesus, and He saved us from our sin. Each Evangelize week we will hear some amazing testimonies from our classmates. If you would like to share your testimony here in First Priority, tell one of our Student Leaders or our Campus Coach, so that we can talk with you about it! GOSPEL TOOL

Gospel Tool: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: Make sure to have a picture of "The Four" on a screen or a board to reference during the gospel presentation. You can also reach out to the First Priority office or your Campus Coach about purchasing gospel bracelets for your club.

**CREDIT: "The Four" - Campus Crusade for Christ*



This month's gospel tool is called "The Four" and uses four symbols.

The **heart** symbolizes God's heart and love for us. John 3:16 says, *"For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."* The **division symbol** represents the sin that divides and separates us from God. To sin means to "miss the mark" or to fall short of God's standard. Romans 3:23 says, *"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."* The **cross** reminds us that Jesus died to save us from our sins. In John 14:6, Jesus tells us that He is *"the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."* The **question mark** represents a question that we all must answer: Do I know Jesus and have a personal relationship with Him?

You may be thinking, "How do I have a personal relationship with Jesus? How can I know God?" Romans 10:9 says, *"If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."* If we want to surrender our lives to Jesus, we must confess our sins to God, declare that Jesus is Lord, and believe that Jesus is the only Way to God. If you want to begin a relationship with Jesus, I will take my time as I say this prayer so you can repeat after me: **LEADER TIP:** Say this slowly in clear, short phrases: *"God, I confess to You that I am a sinner and I ask for Your forgiveness. I believe that You sent Your Son, Jesus, to die for my sins. I believe that He rose again and is the only Way to You. Today, I surrender my life to You. I want to know You. Thank You for loving me. In Jesus' Name, amen."*

If you made a decision to follow Jesus today, we want to celebrate with you! This is an amazing decision! If you have questions or you aren't sure yet about giving your life to Jesus, our Student Leaders or our Campus Coach would love to talk with you. Please make sure you fill out a response card before you leave and give it to one of our Student Leaders. We want to pray for you, follow up with you, and help you connect to a local church.

LET'S TALK ABOUT IT (OPTIONAL)

LEADER TIP: If you have time available, discuss these questions in a small group or large group setting. For small groups, select a leader for each group.

IMPORTANT: If discussion or a student's personal question(s) drift toward topics too lengthy or difficult for the time allotted, please encourage them to ask the adult leaders in the room after the meeting or refer them to their parents or pastors after school.

GROUP LEADER(S) SAY:

1. Do you really know God and have a relationship with Him?
2. Who do I know that needs to know how much God loves them?
3. How can God use me to help reach every last one on my campus?

LEADER TIP: Explain that reaching EVERY LAST ONE simply begins with the NEXT ONE.
