Month 2: GOSPEL

WELCOME

LEADER TIP: Arriving early to pray over the room, playing worship live or on a bluetooth speaker, and greeting attendees as they enter, creates an environment that welcomes God's presence and people well.

Welcome: _____ (Leader)

SAY: Welcome to First Priority! We are so glad you are here today! This month we have been learning that our purpose is to make God known! This week is EVANGELIZE week, where we will talk about how God can use us to make Him known at our school! Before we leave today, we will all have the opportunity to begin a relationship with Jesus and learn how we can share the gospel with others!

Prayer: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: Feel free to have a student leader pray in their own words or the use prayer below.

SAY: Let's pray. "God, thank You for being here with us. Thank You for sending Jesus to save us! We want to make this good news known! Help us all to know You and make You known today as we share Your good news! In Jesus' Name, amen."

WORSHIP (OPTIONAL)

Worship Transition Talk: _____ (Leader)

SAY: Psalm 71:8 says, "All day long I praise you and proclaim Your glory." Praising God is a way that we can make Him known! Let's proclaim His glory together as we praise Him and make Him known!

LEADER TIP: Worship can be led live or by a lyric video. Test all technology WELL BEFORE club begins. Because students come from diverse worship backgrounds, provide lyrics (in slides, handouts, or a QR code) so everyone can participate. Message Transition Prayer: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: Worship is a powerful time to invite God's presence. To carefully transition into the message, have a student leader pray in their own words or use the prayer below.

SAY: "God, You are so good! We want to make You known with our praise! We pray that Your Word would speak hope to everyone in this room. If someone here doesn't know You, I pray that they would choose to follow You today. In Jesus' Name, amen."

MESSAGE

Scripture: _____ (Leader)

SAY: Today's scripture is from Romans 10:14-15. It says, "How, then, can they call on the One they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the One of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: 'How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!'"

Message: _____ (Leader)

LEADER TIP: Before a club meeting, print enough First Priority RESPONSE CARDS for everyone to receive one. RESPONSE CARDS can be found on the FP AL app within EVANGELIZE WEEK and in CLUB RESOURCES. Following the message, student leaders should collect RESPONSE CARDS to follow up with those who completed them.

SAY: Have you ever experienced something that you couldn't wait to tell someone about? Maybe you earned an award or won a competition. Maybe you traveled to a new place, or you received something that was expensive for free. When we experience these moments, we don't want to keep them to ourselves. We want to tell someone! Did you know that sharing the gospel can be the same way? We can be excited to share the good news of Jesus with others! This good news is that God sent Jesus to save us from sin! Galatians 1:4 says, "Jesus gave His life for our sins, just as God our Father planned, in order to rescue us from this evil world in which we live."

The word "evangelize" means to share the gospel. The best way that we can make God known is by sharing the gospel! Our scripture from Romans 10:14-15 asks some important questions. How can someone hear the gospel if we don't tell them? How can someone know God if we don't make God known? If we have accepted Jesus as our Savior, we should tell others about Him. If we wouldn't keep our own amazing accomplishments to ourselves, why would we keep the good news and hope of Jesus to ourselves? Romans 10:15 says that it is "beautiful" when we share the good news of Jesus!

Sharing your testimony is a great way to make God known! A "testimony" is our story of how we surrendered to Jesus! Now, let's give our attention to _____ *insert student(s) name(s)* as he/she shares his/her testimony!

LEADER TIP: If time permits, the gospel can be shared in this moment using "The Four" gospel tool. Refer to EVANGELIZE Week Month 1 if needed.

Romans 10:9 says, *"If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."* If we want to surrender our lives to Jesus, we must confess our sins to God, declare that Jesus is Lord, and believe that Jesus is the only Way to God. If you want to begin a relationship with Jesus, I will take my time as I say this prayer so you can repeat after me: **LEADER TIP:** Say this slowly in clear, short phrases: *"God, I confess to You that I am a sinner and I ask for Your forgiveness. I believe that You sent Your Son, Jesus, to die for my sins. I believe that He rose again and is the only Way to You. Today, I surrender my life to You. Thank You for loving me. In Jesus' Name, amen."*

If you made a decision to follow Jesus today, we want to celebrate with you! If you have questions or you aren't sure yet about giving your life to Jesus, our student leaders or our Campus Coach would love to talk with you. Please make sure you fill out a response card before you leave and give it to one of our student leaders. We want to pray for you, follow up with you, and help you connect to a local church.

OUTREACH IDEAS (OPTIONAL)

LEADER TIP: Outreach is simply "reaching out" to share the hope of Jesus! You can share Jesus outside of club meetings and invite others to FP! Use the ideas below or create your own. If you need resources, contact your Campus Coach or local church. **BEFORE your outreach, get approval from your Faculty Sponsor and school administration.** Afterward, share approved photos through the CLUB REPORT section of the FP AL app.

- Announce a First Priority encouraging quote of the week during school announcements
- Place posters around your school to promote First Priority
- Pass out candy and FP invite cards to invite your classmates to First Priority
- As a club, volunteer to clean up the school stadium, field, bleachers, gym, or theater after a game or performance
